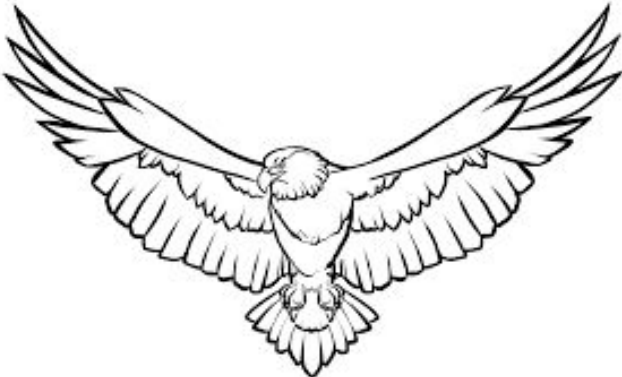
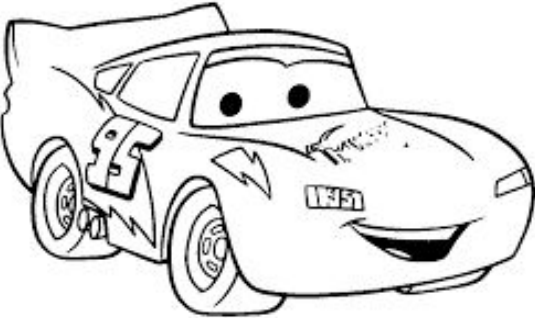

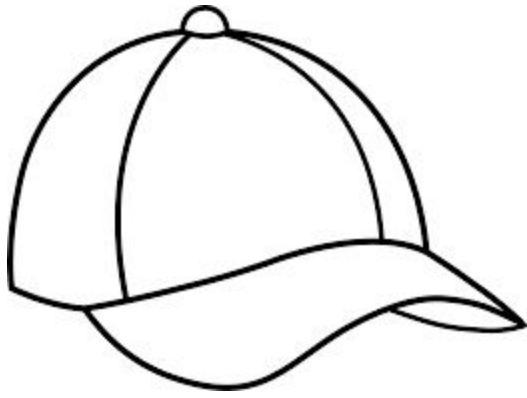


Draw ganache on a cake.

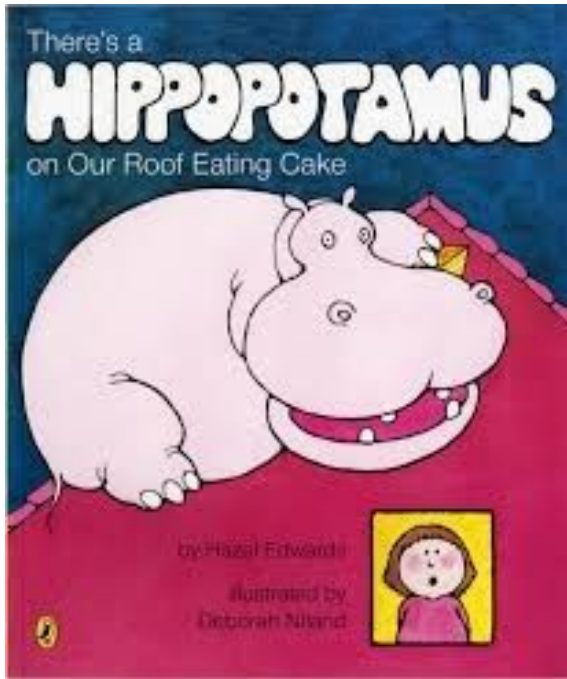
Blue Hat: Problem
